



RoHS II Recast Letter of Compliance

To: All JNJ Distributors and Customers

Subject: RoHS II recast, EU Directive 2011/65/EU as it pertains to the restriction of use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (EEE).

This letter is to certify that JNJ Industries products are in full compliance with the EU regulations as they pertain to RoHS and RoHS II recast, and they do not contain any of the following substances as described in the European Union Directive 2011/65/EU and any of the subsequent updates, that went into effect with the Recast RoHS Directive also known as RoHS 2.0, as detailed below:

2011/65/EU RoHS Recast Directive (RoHS 2.0)

Polybrominated Diphenyl Thers - PBDE	<0.1% (1000 ppm)

Furthermore, JNJ Industries products are not manufactured or packaged with materials that contain any of the substances listed below:

Asbsetos, Azo colorants, Arsenic , Arsenic Compounds, Benzidine and its salts, Benzopyrene, Cadmiun, Cadmium Compounds, Creosote, Decabromo diphenyl ether, Formaldehyde, Halogenated aromatic substances, Halogenated diphenyl methanes, Hexachlorobutadiene, Hexachloroethane, Hexavalent Chromium/Hexavalent Chromium Compounds (in paint or plastic), Lead, Mercury, Mercury Compounds, Mickel, Ozone Delepting Substances (such as CFC's, HCFC's, HBFC's, Freon), Pentachlorophenol, Perfluorocarbons (PFC's), Perfluorooctane Sulfonate (PFO's), Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBB's), Polybrominated Diphenylethers (PBDE's), Polychlorinated Biphenyls (PCB's), Polychlorinated Terphenyls (PCT's), TetrabromobisphenolA (TBBP-A), Tolulene (CAS No. 108-88-3), Tris (2,3 dibromopropyl) phosphate (CAS No. 126-72-7), Tris (aziridiny) – phosphineoxide (CAS No. 545-55-1).

Although the RoHS directive is a European directive, JNJ Industries, being a global supplier of electronic production supplies has elected to comply fully with this directive. To the best of our knowledge, no product sold under the JNJ Industries or GlobalTech trade names contain any of the hazardous substances listed in the directive.
